### Getting to Know You:

### Into the Bible:

3. Did you learn anything new about Psalm 23 from this weekend's message?
  - a. How will it affect your life from now on?
  - b. How have you given the enemy a seat at your table? How can you stop allowing it?
4. Play the voice game (LG leader has instructions)
5. Read John 10:11-18; 27 (out loud in life group)
  - a. How does this passage of Scripture speak to you?
  - b. Do you trust the Jesus is a good shepherd and that he is trustworthy to guide and lead you? Why or why not?
  - c. Do you feel like you recognize his voice (John 10: 18, 27)?
