



YOUTH LEADER

Purpose: To fulfill the vision of the Senior Pastor by;
Being a disciple of Jesus Christ and making disciples through teaching Scripture, living a life of worship, and living what it means to be a follower of Christ (Matthew 28:19-20, 1 Timothy 3:1-7).

Job Description

- Youth leaders are vital to the ministry of the church. Youth leaders are avenues of teaching and mentoring with service and relationship serving as the core utilities and Jesus Christ as the focal point. What it ultimately means to be a leader is this; being a servant of Jesus Christ. In being a servant to Jesus you will be a servant to the people around you (Mark 10:45).

Expectations

- **Personal**
 - A personal relationship with Jesus Christ
 - Consistent devotional time with the Lord in Bible reading and prayer
 - No unrepentant sexual sin
 - Abstaining from the over-indulgence of alcohol and/or any substance (including Marijuana).
 - Consistent church attendance even when not serving
 - Dress Appropriately in a manner that brings honor to God
 - Be aware of what you post on social media
- **Positional**
 - Be faithful
 - Be a servant
 - Be committed
 - Operate in your spiritual gifts or actively working on discovering them
 - You also need to be teachable and willing to be led
 - Be developing healthy relationships with the youth working to always point them back to Jesus
 - This should be in accordance with the Foursquare Child and Youth Protection manual. See Pastor Zac if you have not read it.
 - Be on time to all meetings scheduled
 - Attend the Youth Leaders Life Group
 - Attend youth events outside of Wednesday Nights when possible
 - This would include sporting events and other extra-curricular activities. This is not mandatory, but it is suggested.
 - Be in good relationship with all other leaders
 - Answers to the Youth Pastor
- **Time commitment**
 - Time commitment will vary according to the different events that are being done. However, with youth service (1-1/2 hrs.), Youth Leader Life Group (1 hr.), and attending Sunday morning service (1 hr.) you can expect to serve anywhere from 3-1/2 – 6 hrs. weekly. The 6 hrs. comes from an estimate to be building relationships outside of church with the students. (Does not include personal devotion time)
- **Scheduling**
 - Scheduling can become an issue with all the different people and schedules that are involved. This being said a time will be determined to best fit the needs of our group as a whole so that we can grow in relationship with one another pushing each other to deeper relationships with Christ (Proverbs 27:17).
